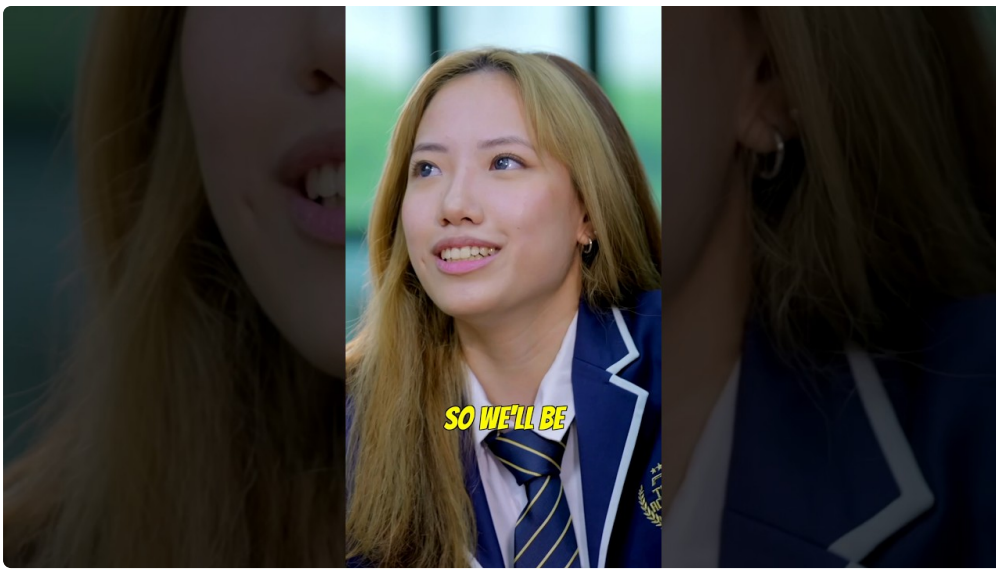


Making It Feel Like They're There
