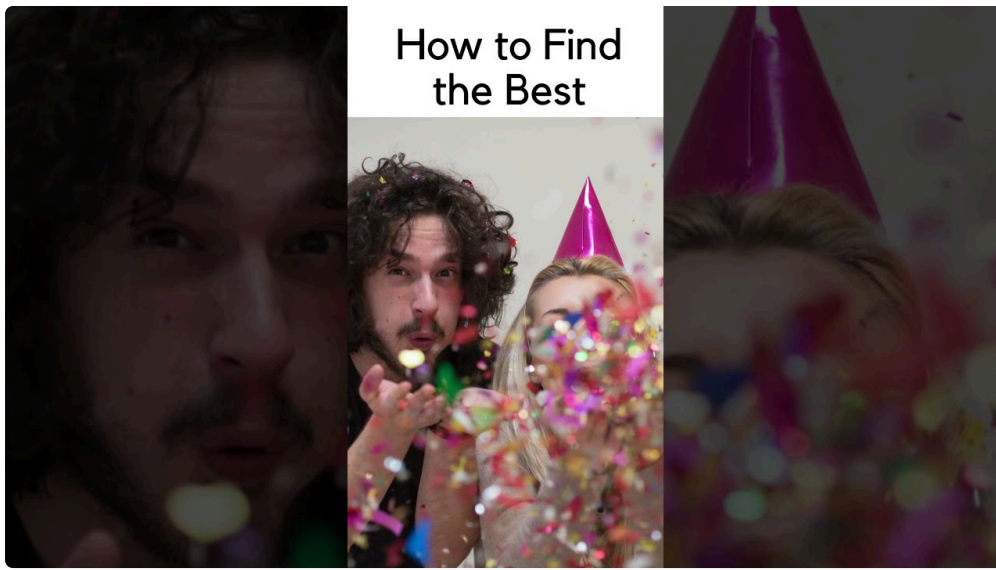


Setting the Musical Vibe
