

SHARED PARENTING AGREEMENT

PREAMBLE

This Shared Parenting Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") is made and entered into on this _____ day of _____, 20____, by and between:

Parent 1: _____ (hereinafter referred to as "Parent 1"), and

Parent 2: _____ (hereinafter referred to as "Parent 2").

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Agreement is to outline the shared responsibilities and rights of both parents regarding the care, custody, and upbringing of their child(ren);

WHEREAS, this Agreement serves to establish a clear and structured approach to co-parenting, ensuring that both parents have a mutual understanding of their roles and obligations;

WHEREAS, this Agreement is designed to promote the child(ren)'s best interests, encourage effective communication between parents, and provide a framework for resolving potential disputes amicably;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereby agree as follows:

DEFINITIONS

Parents:

The individuals who have legal rights and responsibilities towards the child/children under this Agreement.

Children:

The minor(s) who are the subject of this Agreement.

Custody:

The legal and physical custody arrangements regarding where the children will reside and how decisions regarding their upbringing will be made.

Parenting Time:

The schedule and allocation of time that each parent will spend with the children.

Visitation:

The arrangement for a non-custodial parent to spend time with the children.

Dispute Resolution:

The method(s) agreed upon for resolving conflicts that may arise concerning the terms of this Agreement.
