Porous materials like books, upholstered furniture, and cardboard boxes require faster intervention—if drying is accelerated through professional equipment, you may recover 60 to 80 percent of these items rather than losing them entirely. How Rapid Drying Techniques Protect Items Worth Keeping

The speed of drying directly determines your timeline for deciding what can be saved. Fabrics and clothing can usually be recovered if drying begins within 48 hours; electronics may be salvageable if dried within 24 hours using specialized low-temperature techniques; important documents and photos often require pack-out to a climate-controlled facility where they dry more carefully over days or weeks.
