Best Materials for Grapple Loading

Grapple trucks are best suited for large, bulky items such as tree sections, brush, logs, pallets, and certain clean wood materials. Mixed demolition waste, concrete, roofing, chemicals, and hazardous materials may require a different container or hauling provider.

Keep Materials Separated

Separating clean vegetative debris from construction waste can make loading safer and disposal more efficient. Contractors should identify the material type before scheduling and provide photos of the pile.



Job-Site Access and Coordination

The truck needs a stable setup area and enough room for the boom to operate. Coordinate around other equipment, workers, deliveries, traffic, and overhead utilities. Debris should be staged in a reachable zone before pickup.
