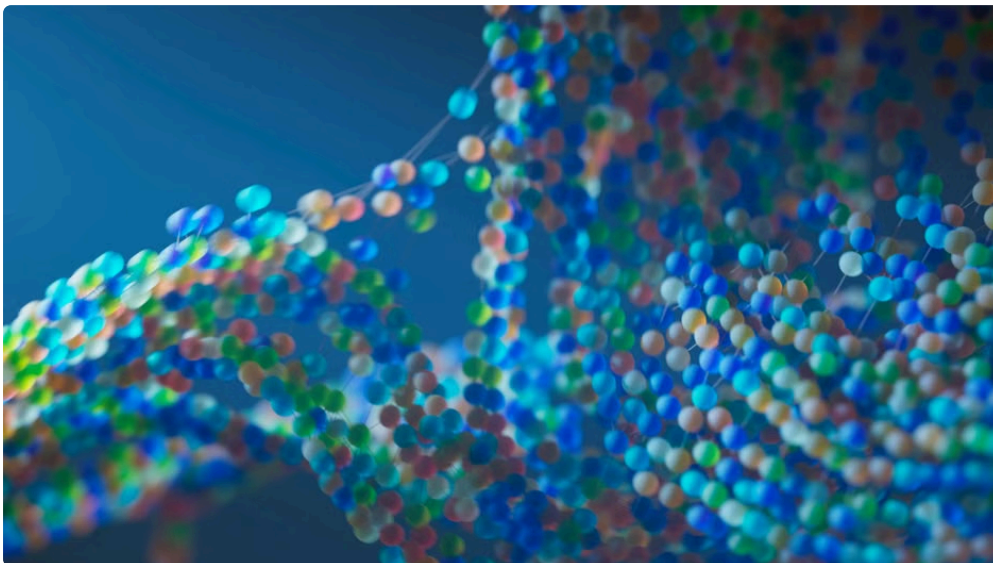
Single Sign-On (SSO) is a must-have for enterprises prioritizing security and user management. Suprmind Enterprise supports robust SSO implementations:
