If you are mounting near salt air or aggressive cleaners, specify stainless or aluminum components where offered, and seal all area cuts. 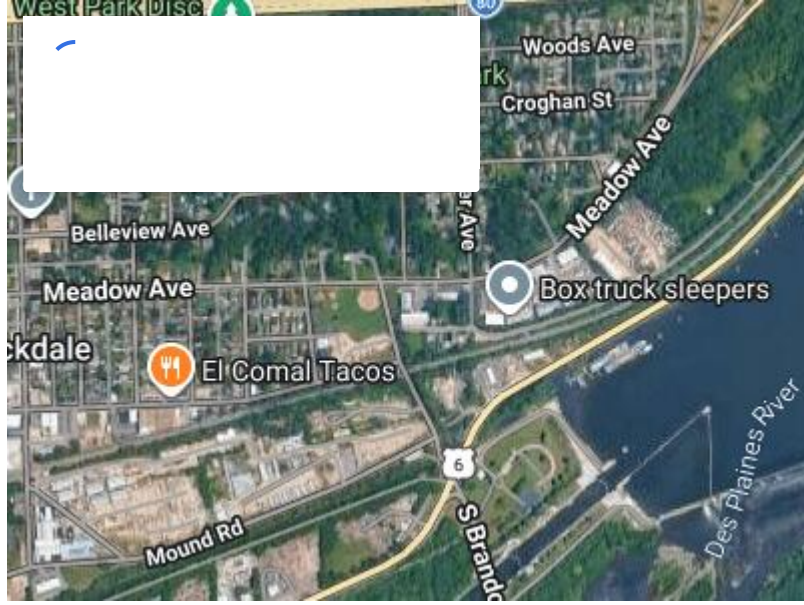
