4. Neighborhood Scavenger Hunt

And it's a great way to learn about the community. Create a list of items to find in the neighborhood. Or "find the park with the big slide". Divide kids into teams. And have a prize for the first team to find everything. Make it a themed hunt. For safety, provide a map. This hunt is perfect for ages 6–14

5. Treasure Hunt

A treasure hunt is a classic scavenger hunt. Leading to a hidden treasure. And the final clue leads to the treasure. And have them work in teams. This adds a mental challenge. With costumes and decorations. This ensures everyone feels like a winner. And it's great for a pirate, jungle, or adventure-themed party

6. The Educational Adventure

An alphabet scavenger hunt is perfect for younger kids. Create a list of items that start with each letter of the alphabet. For younger kids, use pictures instead of words. The first team to complete the alphabet wins. Like a "nature alphabet" or a "kitchen alphabet". And have a "show and tell" at the end. This hunt is perfect for ages 3–6

A sensory scavenger hunt is perfect for younger kids. Create a list of textures. Like a soft stuffed animal, a rough rock, and a smooth leaf. Like "find something that is cold" or "find [Kollysphere Events](#) something that is heavy". And small prizes for everyone. Like a "nature sensory hunt" or a "kitchen sensory hunt". Where kids can share their findings. This hunt is perfect for ages 2–5

10. A Race for Information

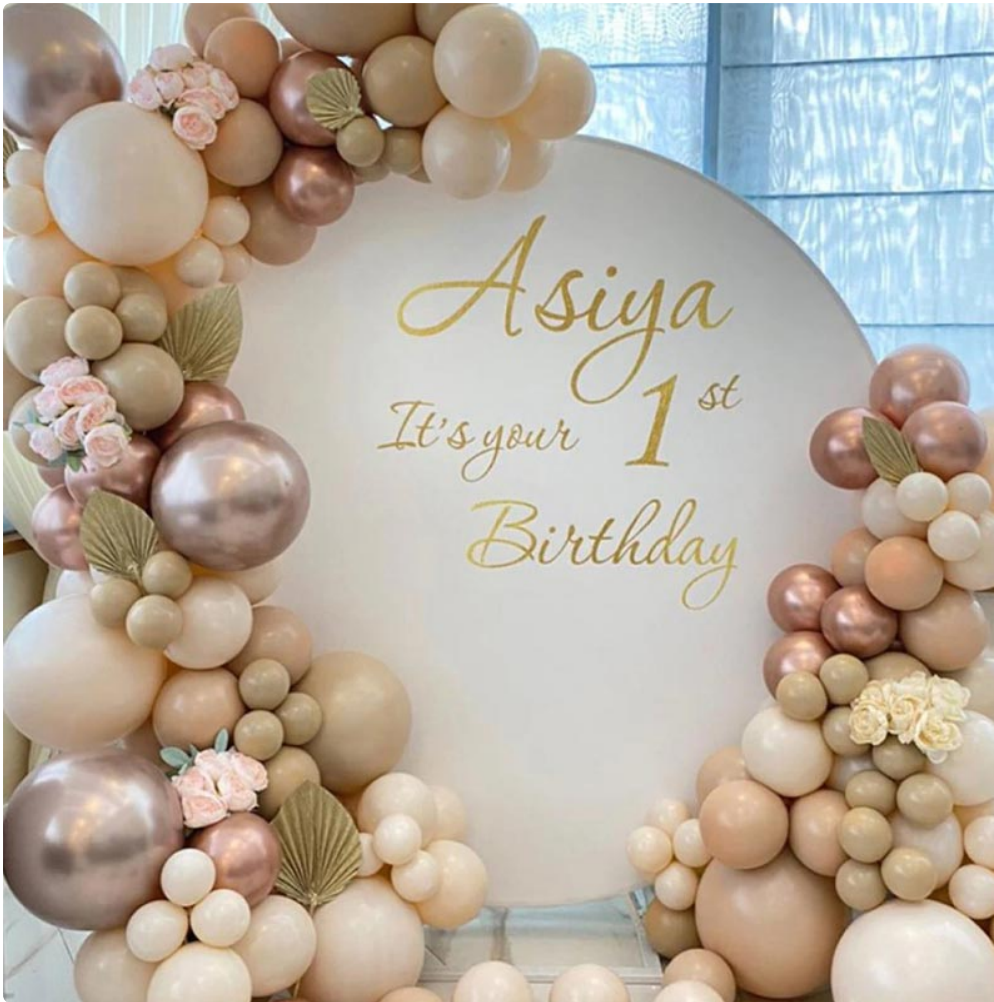
