How Transactions Work: Steam API and P2P Trading

Today, many platforms utilize **Peer-to-Peer (P2P) systems**.

3. The site credits the depositor's account balance once the trade is validated.

This technique helps platforms prevent direct participation in managing Valve's stock products while keeping the virtual economy flowing.
