4. Coinflip

A simple 1v1 game mode where two gamers wager comparable skin values. A virtual coin is turned, offering each participant an approximately 50% possibility to double their <https://cs2skin.com/> inventory or lose it completely.

5. Prize

Numerous players pool their skins into a main pot. A wheel spins, and a winner is selected. The higher a player's contributed worth relative to the total pot, the higher their statistical possibility of winning the entire swimming pool.
