Balance and Speed

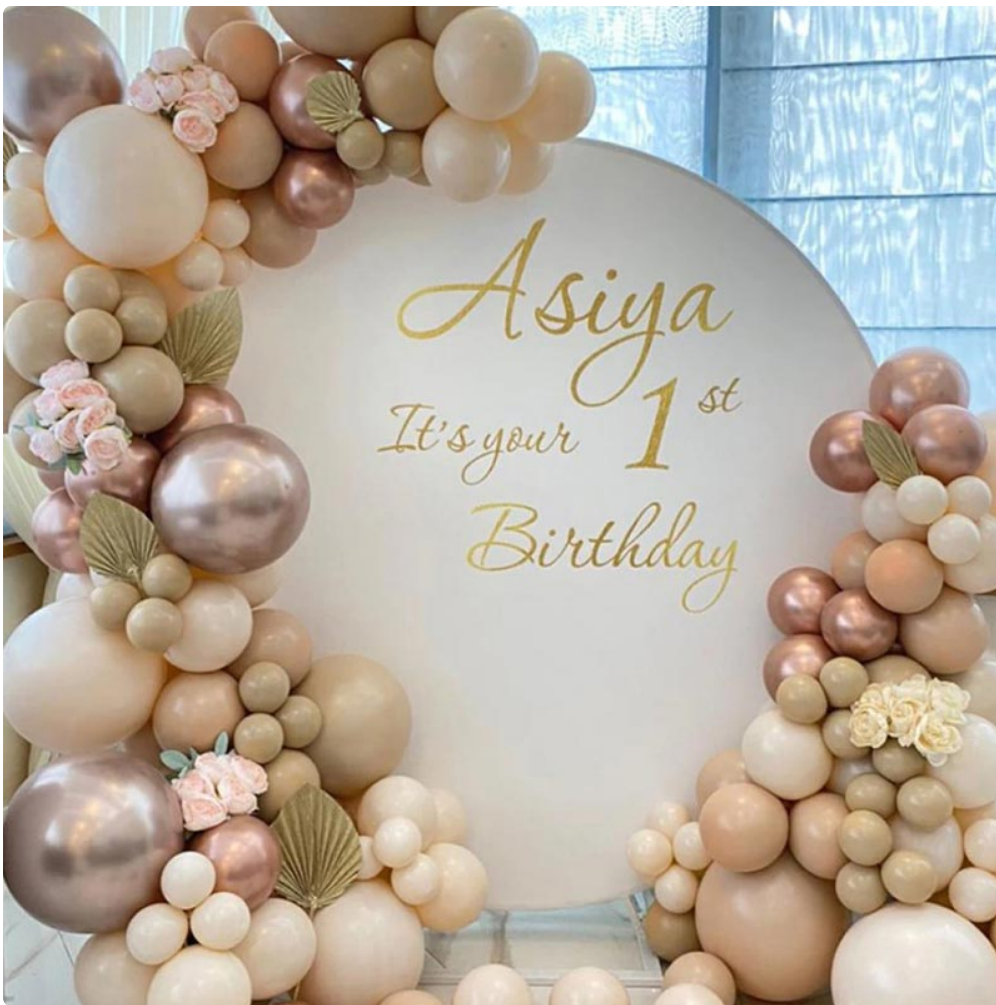
In Stack Attack, players must pile a set of plastic cups into a pyramid and then dismantle them as quickly as feasible. The fastest time triumphs.
