The floorings are clear, the bollards look right, and over the loading bay you'll often identify a rounded account of a rolling steel fire door with a red test tag hanging from the overview. Stainless or powder-coated surfaces make their keep if you wash down floorings or shop chemicals.

Guides lose from lift trucks and from winter season salt. We size overviews generously and, where possible, recess defense posts a couple of inches outside the clear opening. A straightforward steel hood keeps snow thaw from dripping onto the barrel where it can ice up the drape in place.

The last reality is clearance. A fire door requires its area. Clear 6 to 12 inches around the guides for solution and aim for 24 inches at the hood for safe springtime work. In a West Side print center, we did the opposite. The rated moving door does double duty as a security shutter during the night, so it runs numerous times daily on a standard motor with monitored security side and horn strobe. Hands-on reset after a release serves since trained supervisors are constantly on shift, and the door shows up from the control desk. The group logs regular monthly functional checks and keeps spare fusible links on website. Both configurations are correct for their contexts.

Cold weather, corrosion, and various other Midwestern headaches

A door that runs flawlessly in September can study problem by January. Chicago's freeze-thaw cycle worries anchors and seals, and roofing system melt drips right into places you would not expect. 3 useful lessons have conserved our customers time and money:

Keep water off the barrel. If there is any type of roofing or pipeline leakage above the hood, solution that first. Ice on the barrel can fuse a drape to itself. Protect what you repaint. Painters with sprayers like to make equipment look brand-new. 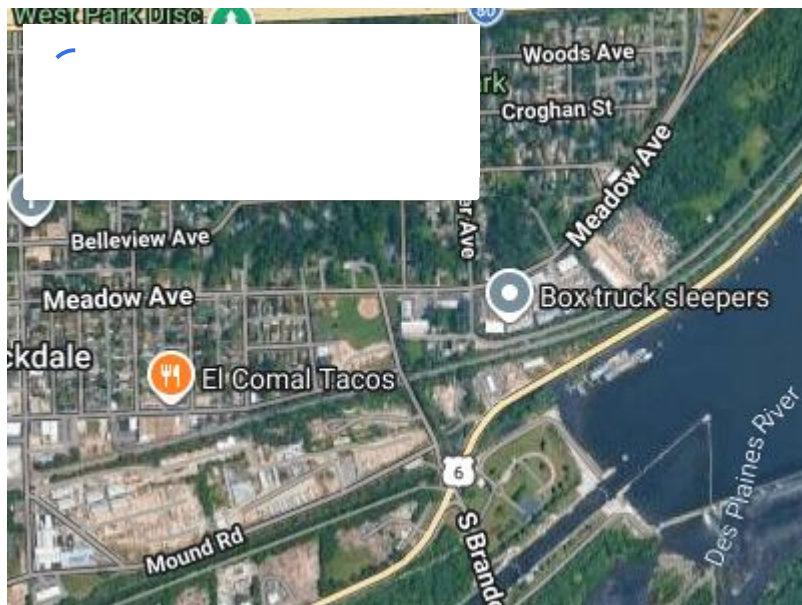
