We checked moisture at questionable trim - readings hovered at 12 to fourteen % after a dry spell - then primed with a tannin-blocking off acrylic on sanded cedar. We returned-brushed two coats of a satin acrylic on the body and used a barely diminish sheen on the crown particulars to maintain glare down below the afternoon solar.

The homeowner informed me later that the wonderful funds spent became now not the paint logo but the time budgeted for caulking and spot-priming at elevation.
