While **no method can conquer the mathematical house edge**, understanding these systems can assist players manage their bankrolls more efficiently.

1. The Martingale Strategy

- **How it works:** The gamer doubles their bet after every loss. When they ultimately win, the profit covers all previous losses plus an earnings equivalent to the original base bet.
- **The Risk:** Requires a huge bankroll and can quickly hit table limits or run out of funds during a long losing streak (e.g., a number of consecutive 1.00 x crashes).

2. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli)

- **How it works:** The gamer doubles their bet after every *win*, taking advantage of winning streaks, and resets to the base bet after a loss.
- **The Risk:** A single crash erases accumulated earnings, however limits the risk to just the preliminary base bets.

3. The Low Auto-Cashout Grind

- **How it works:** Setting an automated cashout at a really low multiplier, such as **1.10 x to 1.20 x**, intending for high-frequency, little wins.
- **The Risk:** While win rates are high, a single 1.00 x crash or a fast succession of low crashes can quickly erase lots of little wins.
