

The drum seal and thermal fuse rank among the most expensive dryer parts to replace, often costing \$300–\$400 in labor and materials combined. Why does the thermal fuse cost more to replace on low-reliability dryers?

The thermal fuse itself is inexpensive—typically \$20–\$50 in parts. The labor cost to access and replace it, however, can run \$150–\$250, depending on your dryer's internal architecture. On poorly designed budget dryers, the thermal fuse sits deep within the chassis, requiring extended disassembly. More critically, a repeated thermal fuse failure signals a premature-failure exposure in your dryer's heating circuit or airflow system. If your dryer is blowing fuses every 18 months because it was built with an undersized thermal pathway or inadequate lint management, each replacement becomes a rolling repair cost. Premium dryers are engineered to minimize fuse replacements through superior dust filtration and measured heating cycles; budget models leave you vulnerable to a cycle of recurring failures that a single replacement cannot fix.
