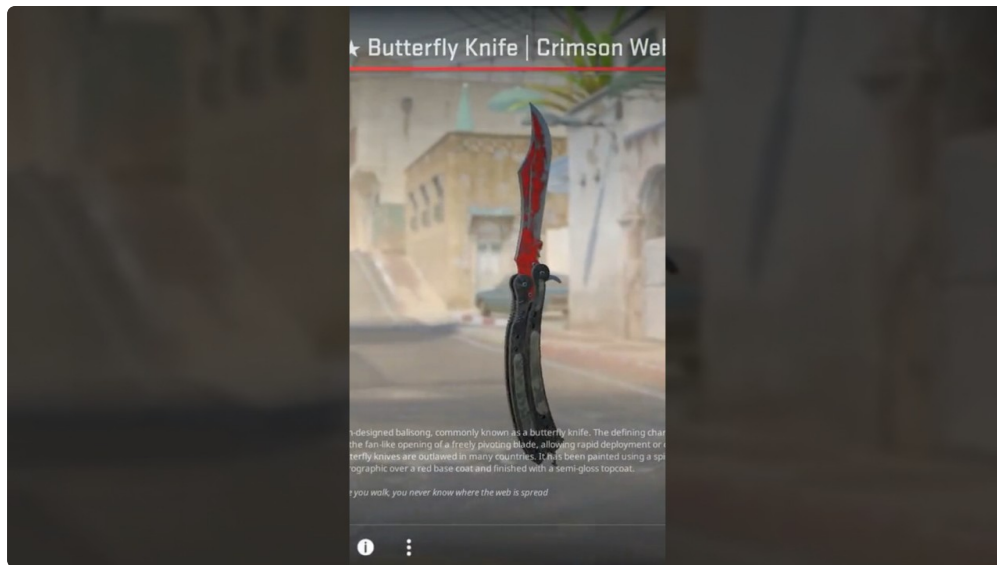
Drop Rates and Odds

While Valve releases the general odds for each case, the exact chance of getting a specific knife varies. Below is an example of the published odds for a popular case-- the "CS: GO Weapon Case 30"-- which is known to contain numerous knife types.

Item Rarity	Approximate Drop Rate
Mil-Spec (Blue)	~ 80%
Restricted (Purple)	~ 15%
Classified (Pink)	~ 4%
Covert (Red)	~ 0.65%
Rare Special Item (Knife)	~ 0.26%

Note: The specific possibility for a specific knife (e.g., Karambit|Fade) is a portion of the rare special item swimming pool.

These numbers highlight that the frustrating bulk of openings will produce basic skins, not knives. The low possibility makes knife openings a high-risk, high-reward activity.



Popular Knife Types and Market Values

Knife skins are classified by their rarity and visual appeal. Below is a table summing up some of the most sought-after knives and their typical market value varieties (as of early 2026):

- Comprehend the Odds**-- Recognize that the huge bulk of openings will not yield a knife. The expected return is unfavorable.
- Prevent Chasing Losses**-- If a player spends an established budget without acquiring a knife, it is suggested to stop instead of effort to "win back" losses.
- Consider Trading**-- Once a knife is gotten, gamers can keep it hoping for future cost gratitude or trade it immediately for other items or cash.
