Then the work stops being woodworking and becomes judgment. Not just craftsmanship, however border recognition, reasonable construct options, and communication that stops troubles long after the last paling is screwed down.

When customers claim "wood paling fencing," they might be picturing a certain look: short, a regular light spacing, and a leading rail that feels cool and degree. Others have an even more conventional assumption, with broader spacing or a somewhat uneven rhythm that matches older fences in the area.

But "similar" isn't the like "identical," and it matters for both appearance and efficiency. Paling spacing impacts wind tons and just how quickly leaves and particles accumulate. The thickness and account impact exactly how the fencing endures drying and motion over seasons. The height impacts the level of neighbor visibility and regional compliance requirements.
