

Summary of Fulton, NY Trip Costs

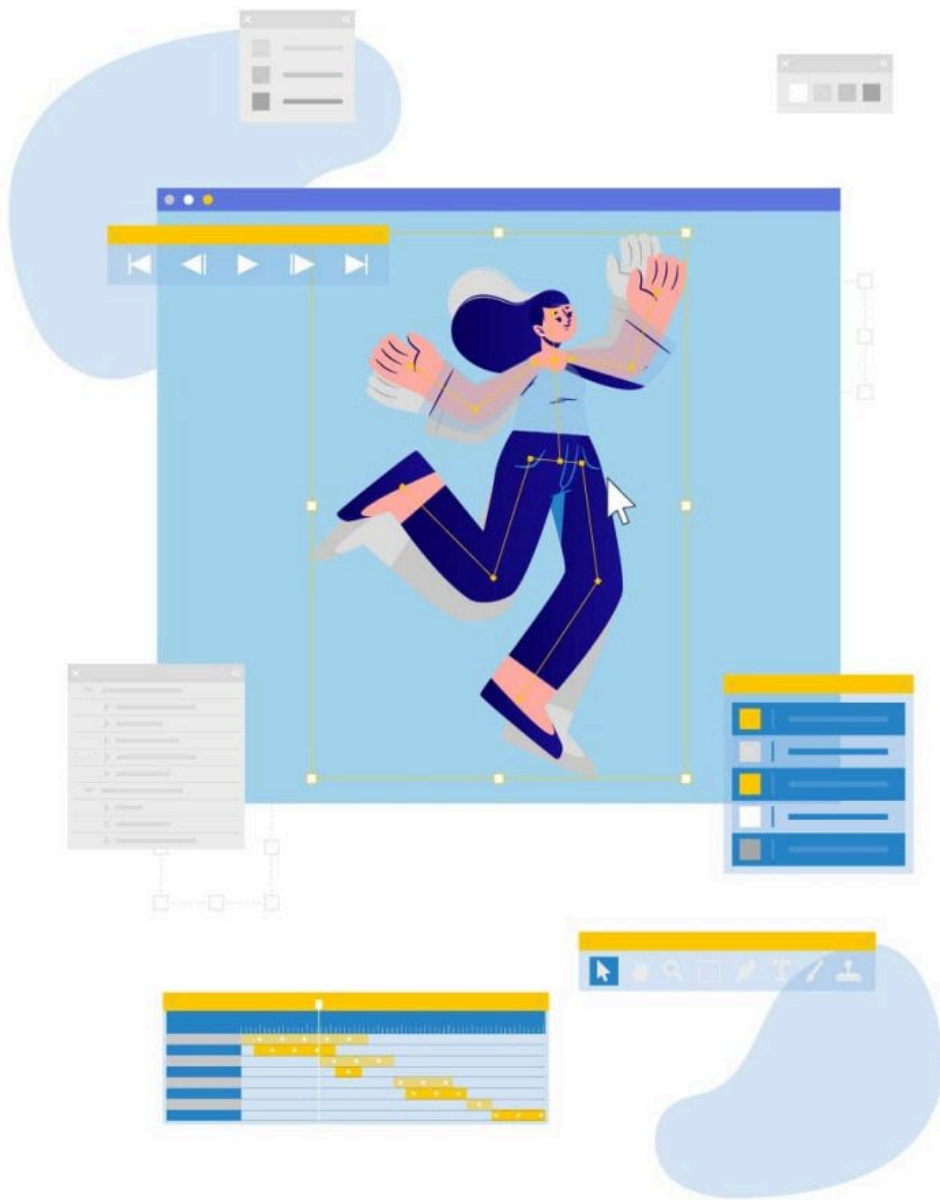
