

Facial swelling connected to a dental issue can indicate a serious infection, and Whites Dental Marble Arch treats this symptom as an urgent priority requiring prompt assessment. Swelling that spreads beyond the immediate area of the tooth, or that is accompanied by fever, should be treated as a medical priority and addressed as quickly as possible. The practice's dentists examine the source of the swelling to determine whether drainage, antibiotics or further treatment such as extraction or root canal is needed.

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Patients experiencing significant facial swelling alongside dental pain are advised to contact the practice immediately rather than waiting to see if it subsides on its own.
