In a downtown loft with concrete flooring and metallic home windows, the homeowners wanted the kitchen to behave like part of the dwelling section. We used a thin porcelain slab with a mushy limestone print, mitered to learn as a two-inch facet. The backsplash ran complete top, shops moved to the underside of the higher cabinets, and the island had no overhang at the window side, so it examine like a monolith in place of a bar.
