Preparing for a Rainy Move Day

Checking the forecast a few days before the move gives households time to prepare extra supplies such as plastic sheeting, tarps, and waterproof mattress covers. Wet driveways and walkways create a slip hazard for anyone carrying heavy furniture, so laying down rubber mats or absorbent runners near entry points helps keep footing secure throughout the move. Protecting Belongings from Water Damage

Plastic wrap or moving blankets with a waterproof layer help keep couches, mattresses, and wood furniture dry throughout loading and transport.

Timing the Move Around Storm Patterns

Texas thunderstorms often follow a predictable daily pattern during certain seasons, building up in the afternoon after a clear morning. Scheduling the bulk of the loading and transport for earlier in the day can help households

avoid the worst of an afternoon storm, especially during late spring and [austin movers InNout Movers Austin](#) early summer months.

Lightning presents a safety concern that goes beyond simple rain protection. If a storm brings frequent lightning, pausing the move temporarily until the worst of it passes protects both the crew and anyone helping load the truck from unnecessary risk.

Vehicle Safety in Wet Conditions

Moving trucks navigating wet roads need extra following distance and reduced speed compared to dry conditions, especially on Austin highways prone to standing water during heavy downpours. Checking real-time traffic and weather updates throughout the day also helps the crew reroute quickly if a road becomes impassable partway through the move.
