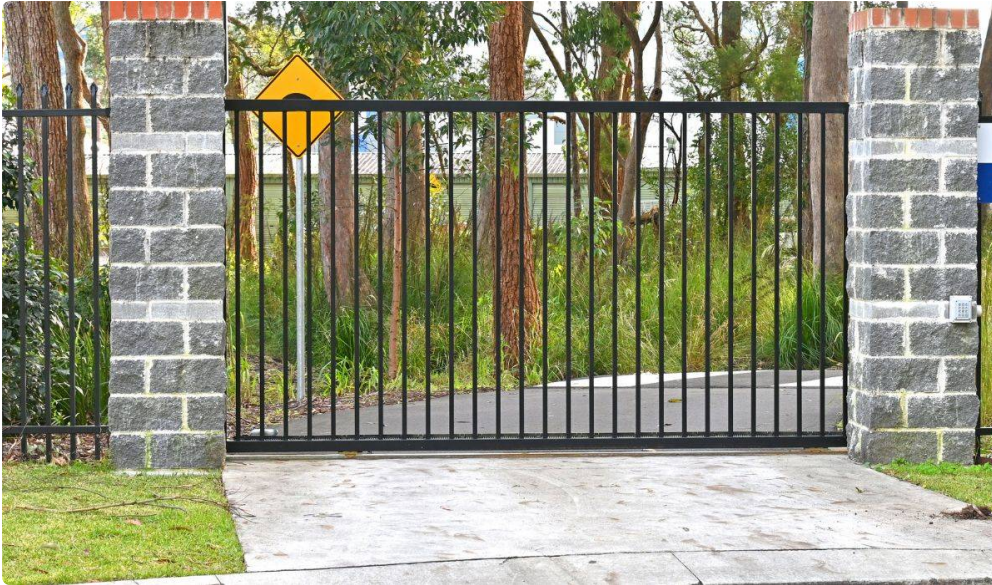

Both torsion spring and extension spring systems require cautious handling. A torsion spring is mounted above the door and stores energy by twisting. Extension springs are positioned along the horizontal tracks and stretch as the door moves. Each system has distinct parts and service requirements.
