- **The Risk:** Requires a huge bankroll. Hitting a long losing streak can rapidly exhaust a gamer's funds or hit site wagering limitations.

2. The Anti-Martingale (Paroli) Strategy

- **How it works:** The player doubles their bet after every *win* and resets to the base bet after a loss. This aims to capitalize on winning streaks while reducing exposure throughout cold streaks.
- **The Risk:** A single late loss eliminates the built up earnings of the streak.

3. Low Auto-Cashout Grinding

- **How it works:** Players set an automated cashout at a very low multiplier, such as **1.10 x to 1.20 x**, and location larger bets.
- **The Risk:** While winning portion is high, an instant 1.00 x crash will clean out numerous wins in a single blow.
