We sprayed a committed adhesion primer, sanded to 320, then sprayed two coats of a waterborne alkyd satin. Doors hung on day 4, with bumpers established to keep away from sticking. The proprietor waited a week formerly loading shelves. Total time, 8 operating days with a four consumer team, just over 400 linear feet of trim, 17 doorways, and 34 cupboard pieces. Three months later, we did a courtesy fee. No blockading, no sags, and the stairwell regarded flat at sunset.
