A pale hand-sanding with maroon pads or 220-grit paper scuffs the surface, but raised grain and open finish-grain on MDF want more considerate managing. We label each door, drill plates for hardware templates, and keep hinges in numbered baggage to continue famous consistent.

If a product calls for a recoat between 2 and six hours, we do now not wait unless hour 10 devoid of a light scuff. That self-discipline is what helps to keep blocking and print-by way of at bay.

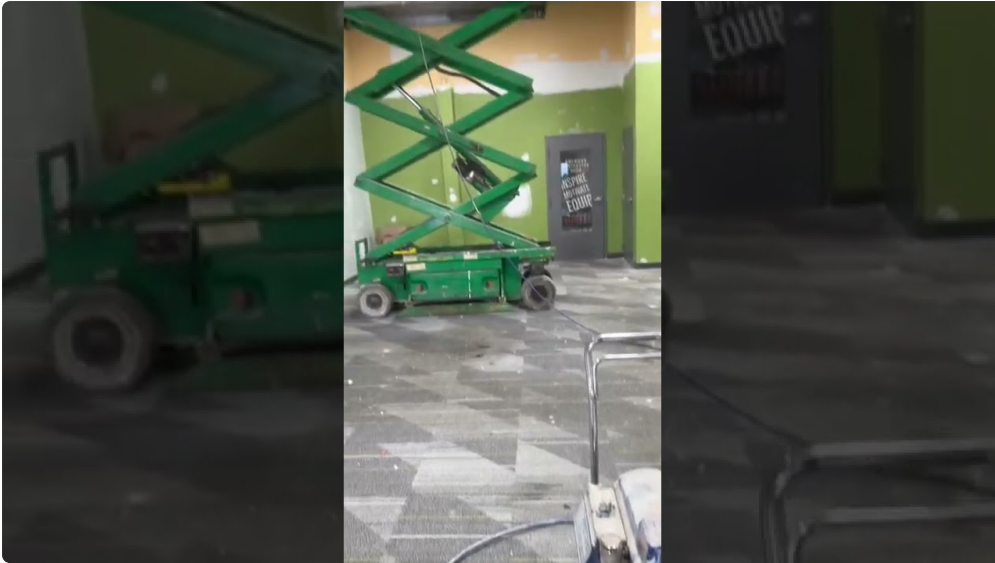

We sanded profiles with foam pads and shot two topcoats of satin urethane. Doors were sprayed flat in the shop with the identical device. Hardware holes were filled and re-drilled to exchange from 3-inch pulls to 5-inch, which required a jig and staying power to continue strains straight.

From arrival to last wipe-down took eight working days. At day 3 after rehang, the end felt dry but we nevertheless entreated comfortable use for a number of weeks. Six months later the client known as, now not with a grievance, but to agenda ceiling painting companies in the adjoining circle of relatives room considering the fact that the cupboards made the previous ceiling glance drained.
