What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live casino video game constructed around a giant, vertical 52-segment wheel. The game is hosted by a live, energetic presenter who spins the wheel, connects with the audience by means of live chat, and guides gamers through the various sectors.

What sets Crazy Time apart from basic wheel games (like *Dream Catcher*) is the addition of a top slot positioned directly above the main wheel. With every spin, the top slot spins concurrently, generating a random multiplier for a particular bet area. If the wheel stops on that spot and a reward or number is increased, gamers can win huge payouts.

Understanding the Wheel Segments

The 52 sections on the Crazy Time wheel are divided into numbers (which pay basic prize money) and bonus rounds (which activate minigames). Understanding the distribution of these segments is vital for handling bankrolls and understanding the video game's volatility.

The Number Bets

Players can place bets on four different numbers: **1, 2, 5, and 10**. Each number corresponds to its payment multiplier if the wheel arrive at it.

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel (highest frequency, least expensive payout of 1:1).
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel (payment of 2:1).
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel (payment of 5:1).

- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel (payout of 10:1).

The Bonus Rounds

The real enjoyment of Crazy Time depends on its four bonus offer rounds. These occupy a combined overall of 9 sections on the wheel, making them rarer to hit, but vastly more rewarding.

1. **Coin Flip** (4 sections on the wheel)
2. **Pachinko** (2 sectors on the wheel)
3. **Cash Hunt** (2 segments on the wheel)
4. **Crazy Time** (1 section on the wheel)

The Four Thrilling Bonus Rounds Explained

When the wheel stops on a perk sector, all players who positioned a bet on that specific bonus offer round are carried to a separate, immersive set (or enhanced reality screen) to take part.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the bonus rounds, [crazy time free play tips](#) Coin Flip involves a coin with a Red side and a Blue side. Each side is designated a random multiplier by the video game system before the flip. The host pulls a lever to turn the coin, and whichever side lands face up awards the player that matching multiplier. If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can in some cases be triggered for a second chance.



2. Pachinko

Influenced by the conventional Japanese arcade video game, the Pachinko perk round includes a massive wall filled with physical pegs. The video game host drops a puck from the top of the board, and it bounces randomly down through the pegs till it lands in among the multiplier zones at the bottom.

- If the puck lands on a **"Double"** value, all multipliers at the bottom of the wall double, and the puck is dropped again for even greater stakes.

3. Cash Hunt

Money Hunt is an interactive shooting gallery minigame. Gamers are presented with an enormous screen showing 108 random multipliers hidden behind various signs (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).

- Gamers utilize an on-screen crosshair to objective and "shoot" their selected symbol before the timer goes out.
- When time expires, all symbols reveal their covert multipliers, and players receive the multiplier connected to their chosen target.

4. Crazy Time

The crown gem of the game is the Crazy Time bonus offer round. Players walk through a red door into a dynamic, virtual wonderland featuring a huge, 64-segment mega wheel.

- Before the wheel is spun, gamers should select among 3 flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow**.
- The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the chosen flapper points to is granted to the gamer.
- Much like Pachinko, this wheel features **"Double"** and **"Triple"** segments. If the flapper arrive at among these, the multipliers on the wheel increase, and the wheel is spun once again-- potentially pressing payments as much as the video game's optimum limitation of **20,000 x**.

Secret Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is essentially a game of possibility powered by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and a physical wheel, gamers frequently embrace particular wagering strategies to handle their risk and extend their playtime.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe & Steady Strategy (Number Betting):**
 - Focus mainly on wagering on numbers 1 and 2, while placing small hedge bets on perk rounds. This approach yields regular, smaller sized wins and keeps the bankroll stable.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**
 - Place bets solely on the 4 bonus rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time). This is a high-volatility method created for gamers who want to experience the minigames as frequently as possible, accepting that they may experience droughts of non-bonus spins.
- **The Balanced Spread:**
 - Cover a mix of numbers and all four bonus rounds proportionally. This makes sure that almost every spin of the wheel yields some form of return or triggers a function.

Vital Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a set bankroll before visiting and never chase losses.
- **Understand RTP:** Keep in mind that various bets have a little different Return to Player portions. Number bets usually use a higher statistical RTP than bonus offer bets, but bonus offer bets offer the enjoyment of massive multipliers.
- **Enjoy the Show:** Crazy Time is designed as home entertainment initially. Deal with the potential earnings as a reward to the interactive, game-show experience.
