Tips for Responsible Knife Opening

- **Set a Budget**-- Decide in advance how much you are ready to invest. Deal with the cash as home entertainment cost, not an investment.
- **Understand the Odds**-- Recognize that the large bulk of openings will not yield a knife. The anticipated return is negative.
- **Prevent Chasing Losses**-- If a player invests an established spending plan without getting a knife, it is suggested to stop rather than attempt to "win back" losses.
