3.3. Understand Odds and Expected Value

The expected worth (EV) of a bet represents the typical quantity a gamer can anticipate to win or lose per system bet. For a 50/50 coin flip, the EV is 0 (no house edge). For live roulette, the existence of the green "0" pocket develops a negative EV for the player.

When assessing a bet, ask:

- What is the payout relative to the real possibility?
- Does the website take a commission (rake) that further erodes EV?

By consistently preferring bets with an EV close to no (or favorable, when skill-based), the player reduces the long-term benefit of your home.

3.4. Utilize Skill-Based Wagering
