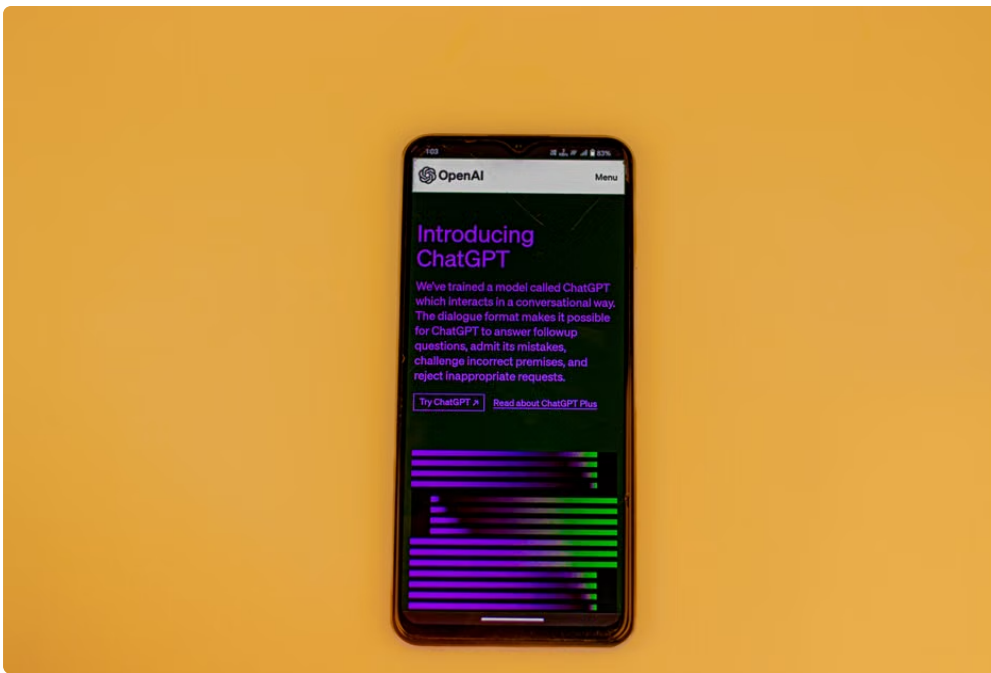

## Amazon's Stake in OpenAI Group PBC: Roughly 5%

Reports estimate Amazon's stake in OpenAI Group PBC at somewhere around 5%. While \$50 billion is a large number, it is important to view it in the context of:

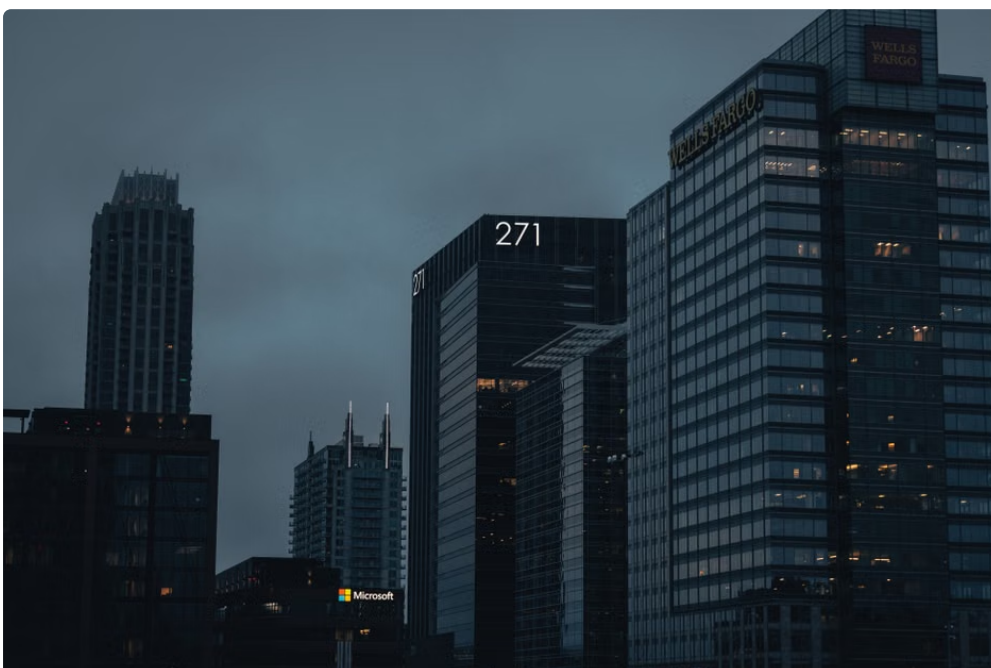

- Acts as a watchdog to prevent any single investor—regardless of size—from exercising undue influence or shifting the organization away from its public benefit mission.
- Maintains a majority of voting rights on the board, preserving mission integrity even with huge outside investments.

This means that although Amazon invests billions, it does not gain majority or decisive voting control. Instead, governance is designed to be mission-driven and somewhat independent from simple economic ownership.

## OpenAI Terms of Use: Reinforcing the Product's Operational Model

ChatGPT's terms clarify operational and user rights under OpenAI's policies. Key points include:

- **European Terms of Use:** Addressing privacy, data protection, and consumer rights in line with GDPR and other European regulations.
- **Rest-of-world Terms of Use:** Complementing the European terms by outlining global user responsibilities and legal frameworks.

Both terms emphasize that OpenAI operates and provides ChatGPT directly as a service, not through a subsidiary "ChatGPT company," which reinforces OpenAI's position as the sole operator and legal owner of the product.

## Economic Ownership Is Volatile and Often Misreported

Finally, it is important to stress the nature of economic ownership in fast-evolving, high-growth companies like OpenAI:

- **Equity stakes fluctuate:** Frequent funding rounds, option grants, and complex financial instruments mean ownership percentages can shift rapidly.
- **Public reports are often estimates:** Media numbers may vary depending on assumptions, valuations, and undisclosed deal terms.

- **Earnings and returns can be opaque:** Private companies like OpenAI disclose limited information, making full economic ownership details confidential and complex.
