- **Accounting for Side Bet Variance:** Side bets like *21 +3*, *Perfect Pairs*, and *Bust It* offer high payouts, but they also come with a devastating house edge (typically varying from 4% to over 13%). Advanced gamers usually avoid side bets totally, or treat them as a separate, strictly minimal entertainment budget plan.

4. Exploiting Table Psychology and Composition-Dependent Strategy
