We sprayed a dedicated adhesion primer, sanded to 320, then sprayed two coats of a waterborne alkyd satin. Doors hung on day 4, with bumpers hooked up to avert sticking. The owner waited per week sooner than loading shelves. Total time, 8 running days with a four someone staff, simply over four hundred linear toes of trim, 17 doorways, and 34 cabinet pieces. Three months later, we did a courtesy test. No blockading, no sags, and the stairwell seemed flat at sunset.
