

What Garage Door Problems Require Professional Repair?

An overhead garage door is one of the most substantial moving systems in a Los Angeles home. It consists of heavy panels, springs, cables, rollers, hinges, tracks, and an automatic opener. Because these components operate together under substantial tension, a problem that appears minor can quickly become a safety or security issue. A noisy garage door may have worn garage door rollers, loose garage door hinges, dry bearings, or a track that needs cleaning and adjustment.
