Only 20 to 30% of melanomas are found in existing moles while 70 to 80% arise on apparently normal skin. Look for one or more of the following ABCDE characteristics:



Asymmetry. One half does not match the other half.



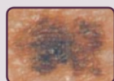
Border is irregular. The mole's edges are ragged, notched or blurred.



Color is uneven. Mole may appear shades of black, brown, tan, red, gray, white, pink or blue.

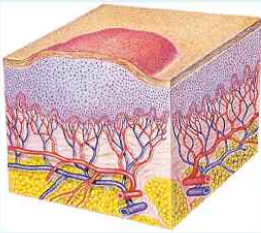
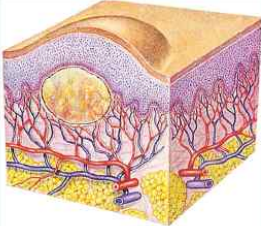
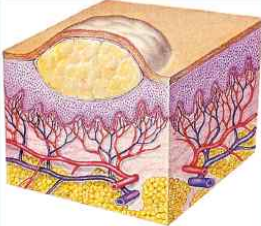
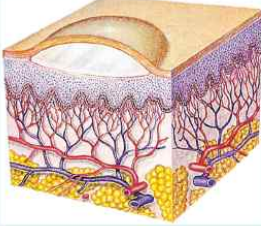


Diameter is larger than 6 millimeters (mm) or ¼ inch, about the size of a pencil eraser. Any sudden or continued increase in size is of special concern.



Evolving. The mole or lesion is changing in size, shape or color.

Wheal Elevated, irregular-shaped area of cutaneous edema; solid, transient, variable diameter	Insect bites, urticaria, allergic reaction	 	<i>Wheal from allergic reaction.</i>
Nodule Elevated, firm, circumscribed lesion; deeper in dermis than a papule; 1-2 cm in diameter	Erythema nodosum, lipoma	 	<i>Fine scaling.</i>
Mass Elevated and solid lesion; may or may not be clearly demarcated; deeper in dermis; greater than 2 cm in diameter	Neoplasms, benign tumor, lipoma	 	<i>Lipoma.</i>
Vesicle Elevated, circumscribed, superficial, not into dermis; filled with serous fluid; less than 1 cm in diameter	Varicella (chickenpox), herpes zoster (shingles)	 	<i>Vesicles caused by varicella.</i>
