

A roof rarely asks for attention in a dramatic way, at least not at first. It tends to signal trouble quietly. Dark streaks start to show up on the north-facing slope. Moss thickens around shaded sections. Gutters collect more grit than usual. From the driveway, the roof just looks a little tired, and many homeowners understandably put it off.
