How Transactions Work: Steam API and P2P Trading

In the past, CS2 gambling websites used bots that straight traded with gamers via Steam accounts. However, Valve has actually broken down on automated trading bots throughout the years by carrying out trade lock durations (items traded can not be re-traded for [CS Gambling Sites](#) seven days) and updating API security.



Today, the majority of platforms utilize **Peer-to-Peer (P2P) systems**.

1. When a gamer wants to deposit, the site pairs them with another player seeking to cash out.
2. The depositing player sends the skin directly to the buyer via a safe and secure Steam trade link.
3. The site credits the depositor's account balance once the trade is verified.

This method helps platforms prevent direct involvement in dealing with Valve's stock items while keeping the virtual economy flowing.

Risks Associated with CS2 Gambling

- **Use Two-Factor Authentication (2FA):** Secure your Steam Guard mobile authenticator and e-mail accounts carefully.
