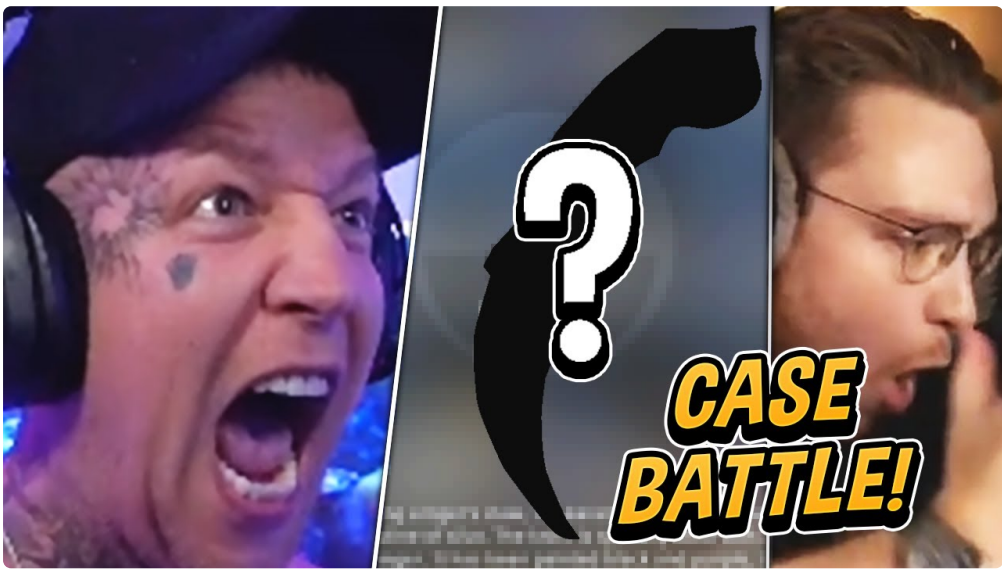
These occasions will act as the battlefield where teams compete for ranking points, cash prize, and the status of being the first CS2 champion.
