A 3rd name got here from Harmony at dusk. An ADV rider dropped into a deep puddle on a trail connector and bent a brake lever. The motorbike ran, but the lever dug into bark as he tried to nurse it out. The shoulder turned into delicate. We winched it up with a extensive strap around the decrease triple, now not the bar, and used a fork saver. The further five mins prevented a fork seal leak that will have cost him a weekend journey.

Fueling issues that odor like a leaky line close a scorching engine are usually not well worth a roadside test. Electrical gremlins that pop fuses mostly can leave you stranded in a worse spot. If you are on a slim shoulder close to Michigan Avenue or a blind crest along Old Canoe Creek Road, even a undeniable process turns into dicy. Get off the shoulder. Call a tow.
